and technical services, working directly with Mother Angelica, the network's founder, on all of her major initiatives. Michael was named President of EWTN in 2000 and assumed the post of Chief Executive Officer in 2009. With the Network's 2011 acquisition of the National Catholic Register, he became its publisher. Michael assumed the post of Chairman of the Board of EWTN in 2013. In that capacity he oversees the network's strategic direction and mission around the world. In 2017, Pope Francis appointed him as a Consultor to the Vatican's Dicastery for Communications.

FR. RAYMOND J. DE SOUZA Host of The Seven Last Words of Christ Father Raymond de Souza has been called "Canada's finest Catholic commentator." Born in Sarnia, Ontario, he earned his Masters in Economics at the University of Cambridge,

and completed theological training at the Pontifical University in Rome. He was ordained in 2002, and serves as pastor of Holy Cross Church in Kemptville, Ontario.

He teaches economics at Queens University, was chaplain for the football team, writes for the National Catholic Register and several other newspapers, and is a senior fellow at Canada's leading Christian think tank. Father Chris Alar is well-known to EWTN audiences for his teaching and devotion to Divine Mercy. He studied industrial engineering at the University of Michigan, receiving his Bachelors and MBA, before embarking on a highly successful business career. But when

the Lord called he answered, eventually earning a Masters of Divinity degree from Holy Apostles Seminary, and joining the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception as a postulant in 2006. Father Chris wrote and produced two popular YouTube series, Divine Mercy 101 and Explaining the Faith, and also wrote the best selling books After Suicide and Understanding Divine Mercy. He currently hosts Living Divine Mercy, airing Wednesdays at 6:30 on EWTN.



ARCHBISHOP EMERITUS THOMAS CARDINAL COLLINS

You might say that Archbishop Emeritus Thomas Cardinal Collins' future was ordained. His childhood home was next door to the church where he served morning Mass. His

high school English teacher, Father Newstead, inspired him to the priesthood. Father Collins received Holy Orders in 1973, and studied Scripture and the Book of Revelation in Rome. He was appointed Bishop of St. Paul, then Archbishop of Edmonton. In 2012, Pope Benedict XVI elevated the then Archbishop of Toronto to the College of Cardinals.

He's participated in Synods on the Eucharist and Middle East, served as an Apostolic Visitor in Ireland and a Delegate of the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith.
